Brook Farm is located 2.5 miles west of the Village of New Paltz. We raise vegetables, berries, herbs and flowers using chemical-free farming methods, including composting and cover cropping, all the while supporting the health of the consumer, the farm worker, and the environment. We also partner with local farms to provide our members with fresh, sustainable eggs, chicken and beef.

Our mission is to inspire positive change by raising public awareness of the profound importance of developing sustainable agriculture. We seek to create a food system that thrives economically, environmentally, and socially by fostering the active cooperation of farmers, consumers, local businesses and business owners, students and educators.

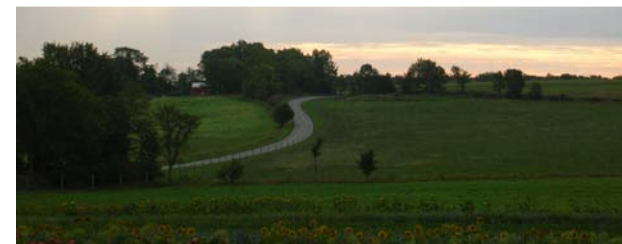
## SHARE THE BOUNTY

Our seven-month season supplies our members each week with exquisite, fresh, nutritious produce, including, but not limited to: Asparagus, Beans, Beets, Broccoli, Carrots, Cucumbers, Eggplant, Flowers, Greens, Herbs, Lettuce, Melons, Onions, Peas, Peppers, Potatoes, Pumpkins, Radishes, Scallions, Spinach, Squash, Tomatoes, and Watermelon. We also offer berries and free-range meat and eggs for sale.
